Part B. CV SUMMARY

In January 2016 I was awarded a PhD summa cum laude by the University of Barcelona. Ever since, my research has been published in top peer-reviewed journals totaling 22 articles, 16 as the first or sole author, with an average of 2.7 accepted papers per year since my PhD. 17 of these 22 papers have been published in journals ranked in the first (11) or second (6) quartile of the JCR Web of Science repository. The track record with respect to these publications proves my ability to handle complex data and to carry out sophisticated statistical analyses, including structural equation models and spatial econometrics. I have participated as a speaker in dozens of national and international congresses organized by entities of international standing. I was also invited twice, in 2016 and 2022, as a keynote speaker by the United Nations Office on Drugs and Crime.

I was also the scientific coordinator of a 2-year project funded under the Horizon 2020 program (MARGIN, GA no. 653004) involving 7 partners from 5 countries, and I am currently part of the EC-funded research (LIFELONGMOVE, GA no. 101043981) under the ERC-Consolidator Grant program. Overall, I have been involved in 9 national and international R+D+I projects.





Between 2017 and 2018, I spent one year as a post-doc visiting researcher at the Federal University of Santa Catarina in Brazil, during which I received intensive training in the use of GIS-based applications, becoming a pro user of QGIS software. In 2022, I was appointed a visiting scholar at Stanford University, under the aegis of Prof. Carnoy.

I currently hold a temporary position as Post-doctoral Fellow at the Department of Sociology of the Autonomous University of Barcelona. A native Italian speaker, I speak fluent Spanish, English and French, as well as intermediate Portuguese and Catalan.
